### Adani Ports to acquire 75% stake in Krishnapatnam Port for Rs 13,572 crore

Billionaire Gautam Adani-led Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone (APSEZ) on Friday said it will acquire a majority stake in Krishnapatnam Port Company (KPCL) from Hyderabad-based CVR Group for Rs 13,572 crore. "The company intends to acquire 75 per cent stake of Krishnapatnam Port Company Limited from its existing shareholders," Adani Ports said in a filing to the Bombay Stock Exchange.KPCL is engaged in the business of handling containers, coal, break bulk and other bulk cargo including liquid cargo. It is a multi-cargo facility and handled 54 million metric tonnes (MMT) of cargo in the financial year 2018-19. The revenue for FY19 was Rs 2,394 crore.

## DP World unveils \$1bn Bangladesh logistics infrastructure investment plan

Dubai-based terminal operator DP World wants to invest US\$1bn in Bangladesh's container supply chain infrastructure, including ports, rail network and inland container terminals.The global port giant has tabled a formal proposal to Bangladesh's government after a meeting organised with the Dubai Chamber last month. Last February, DP World chairman Sultan bin Sulayem and Bangladesh Shipping Secretary Abdus Samad signed memorandum of understanding on a similar proposal.

### Gateway Distriparks registers 215% revenue growth in Apr-Dec 2019



The integrated intermodal logistics provider, Gateway Distriparks' revenue increased by 215% to Rs 1,005.4 crore in nine months from April to December 2019 compared to Rs 319.3 crore of last year.EBITDA increased by 279% to Rs 261.5 crore from Rs 69.1 crore in the same period. PBT and PAT hiked by 27% and 43% respectively for the nine months.

#### Q3 results of Gateway Distriparks

During the quarter ended in December 2019 alone GDL recorded total income of Rs 304.5 crore as against Rs 104.9 Crores for the same period in the previous year, registering a growth of 190 percent. EBITDA increased by 210 percent to Rs 66.1 crore for the Q3 current year from Rs 21.3 crore in Q3 previous year. The increase is due to the consolidation of results as GDL increased its shareholding in GatewayRail. Consolidated PBT reduced by 26 percent to Rs 14.4 Crores from Rs 19.5 crore. PAT before minority increased to Rs 16.4 crore from Rs 16.3 crore in the corresponding quarter of the previous year.

## Adani arm set to buy GMR Group's greenfield port/SEZ in Kakinada



Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone Ltd (APSEZ) is set to buy an under-construction greenfield commercial port in Kakinada and the adjoining SEZ located at Kona village in Thondangi mandal of East Godavari district, promoted by the Hyderabad-based GMR Group.

### Adani raises first US PP from India for a decade

Adani Transmission claims to be India's largest private electricity transmission company, with over 14,000km of power lines and over 3m customers. It is part of the Adani Group, whose operations range from financial services to defence. Adani Transmission made Rp28.6bn (\$400m) of operational Ebitda in financial year 2019, from revenue of Rp73bn (\$1bn).

Bank of America and Barclays arranged the transaction, which has been almost a year in the making. According to two sources familiar with the situation, Barings, Cigna, HSBC Global Asset Management and MetLife bought the 30 year amortising debt

### Adani Ports Mundra LNG terminal gets 1st cargo, commissioning seen Feb

Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone Ltd's Mundra port has received its first cargo of liquefied natural gas paving way for the commissioning of long-delayed 5mtpa joint venture–GSPC LNG Ltd–next month, sources said.The terminal received 140,000 tn liquefied natural gas cargo today, they said.The 55bln-rupee project was completed in 2018 and inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, but could not be commissioned due to disagreement between Adani Group, which holds 25% in the LNG project and Gujarat state-owned entities that hold the rest.

### India: Cargo volume at 12 major ports marginally up at 524 MT in April-December

he country's 12 major ports recorded a marginal 0.98 per cent growth in cargo volumes at 524.02 million tonnes (MT) during the April-December period this year, according to the Indian Ports Association (IPA).The ports had handled 518.93 MT of cargo during the corresponding period of the last financial year.India has 12 major ports — Deendayal (erstwhile Kandla), Mumbai, JNPT, Mormugao, New Mangalore, Cochin, Chennai, Kamarajar (earlier Ennore), V.O. Chidambaranar, Visakhapatnam, Paradip and Kolkata (including Haldia).
